“The Dream Pitch”

Characters:

**Contestants: you will choose one of the below characters to audition as.*

Lily – Creative and optimistic, always bubbling with ideas.

Maya – Logical and slightly skeptical, Lily's best friend.

Setting:

A cozy room filled with art supplies, sketchbooks, and a laptop. The room has a warm, inviting atmosphere.

----ENTER SCENE----

[Lily is sitting at her desk, sketching in a notebook. Maya enters, holding two cups of hot chocolate.]

Maya:

(teasing) So, what's the big idea this time? Another app that tells you when to blink?

Lily:

(grinning) Very funny. No, this one's different. It's a platform where people can pitch their wildest dreams...like, "I want to build a treehouse in the clouds" or "I want to teach a dog how to play chess."

Maya:

(raising an eyebrow) And how exactly do you plan to make that happen?

Lily:

(excitedly) It's not about making it happen. It's about giving people a space to dream big without judgment. They pitch their ideas, and the community votes on which ones are the most fun.

Maya:

(thoughtful) Hmm, I like that. But what if someone pitches something...impossible?

Lily:

(shrugging) Who's to say what's impossible? Maybe someone will pitch "a pizza that delivers itself," and then someone else will figure out how to make it happen.

Maya:

(laughing) Sounds like GrubHub to me.

Lily:

(roles her eyes) Are you mocking my genius?

Maya:

(laughing) Uber Eats? Door Dash?

Lily:

(rolling eyes) Once upon a time, our parents thought stuff like that was impossible. Yet here you sit...watching your pizza inch closer on a map like it's the season finale of *insert name of your favorite show*

Maya:

(dramatically) That season finale...what a cliffhanger! It was soooo good! And, I admit it, so is this idea of yours!

Lily:

(grinning) So, you're in?

Maya:

(mock serious) Only if I get to pitch "a world where Mondays don't exist."

Lily:

(laughing) Deal.

[They clink their cups together.]
